

Article On Digitalisation Montecarlo

Little did Charles Babbage (a British mathematician and inventor, referred to as the "Father of the Computer) know that his invention of modern computing is going to be a global phenomenon.

Modern computing, in the new world being defined as digital, is widely used to describe anything related to or driven by computer technology or the internet.

Digital refers to anything related to digitized data, that is represented in numerical form that can be processed by computers or other electronic devices. The key aspects of digital are:

- Digital Technology that refers to devices like smartphones (mobiles), computers, tablets, wearables, digital cameras, and smart TVs operating using digital signals and technologies like SAP, mobile, AI/ML, IoT, Robotics and AR/VR.
- Digital Data like text files, images, and videos that can be processed, analysed, stored (cloud is the new norm), and transmitted by electronic device.
- Digital Communication that occurs over digital platforms, such as email, messaging apps, social media, and video calls. It involves the exchange of digital data between devices over the internet or other digital networks.
- Digital Media like digital music, movies, eBooks, podcasts, and social media content that is created, distributed, and consumed in a digital format.

The widespread adoption of digital shows no signs of stopping.

Radio and TV took 38 years and 25 years respectively to reach 100 million viewers. These numbers have been dwarfed by Facebook and Instagram that have taken 4 years and 2 years respectively to reach 100 million viewers.

Facebook has over 2.9 billion monthly active users, making it the largest social media platform globally. Instagram boasts over 2.3 billion monthly active users, driven by its visual appeal and features like Stories and Reels. If both these social media platforms were considered countries, they would fall into the top 4 in terms of user population.

- 66% of the global population is on the internet.
- The average global internet user spends 6 hours and 36 minutes online each day.





India is on the verge of breaking all global norms and why should digital be left behind.

As compared to 66% of the global population on the internet, 68% of Indian citizens (955 million) are on the internet, making it the second largest internet market behind China.

India continues to have the largest user base for Facebook and Instagram.

25% online shoppers in India have shopped from social media apps in the past year.

Digital Transformation refers to the integration of digital aspects revolutionizing business processes, front & back-office operations, and customer experiences. This includes industries shifting from traditional to digital models, such as cloud computing, ecommerce, online banking, subscription services, Freemium, Marketplace Model, Peer-to-Peer (P2P), Software-as-a-Service (SaaS), Sharing Economy, On-demand economy, Crowdsourcing, and telemedicine.

Emerging digital technologies are reshaping businesses and have emerged as a key disruptor of our times. Digital is providing breakthrough capabilities at all levels of value chain and there is no ambiguity that we are living in the age of digital disruption with digital technologies not only redefining the business models but also how organizations operate.

Enterprises around the globe are seeking opportunities to accelerate their business operations through adoption of new-age digital technologies for coping with the dynamic market conditions. Technologies such as ERP, AI, cognitive deep learning, and big data analytics are enabling companies to make the leap to smart, data-driven flexible, agile and connected operations.

The senior leadership at Montecarlo is convinced that we need to ride the digitalisation wave to continue being ahead of the curve.

It was thrilling, and the views of the hills and forests surrounding the river made the experience even more amazing. Visit to Rajaji National Park

For nature lovers, a visit to Rajaji National Park, just outside Rishikesh, is a must. We went on a jeep safari and saw elephants, tigers, and many different birds in the wild. The peaceful environment and the sounds of nature made the experience unforgettable.

Komal is an artist who works on different art forms like lippan, mirror mosaic, pichwai, dokra, texture and gond.


